

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

We need you to **TAKE ACTION TODAY.** Reach out to Congressman Kanjorski and request that he support the “Indexed Annuities and Insurance Products Act of 2009”. This bill is authored by Congressman Greg Meeks and will repeal SEC Rule 151A.

It is critical that Congressman Kanjorski hear from constituents and Pennsylvania residents. Even if you do not reside in Congressman Kanjorski’s district we encourage you to still contact his office to express your concern over SEC Rule 151A and ask him to support the Meeks bill. You should emphasize to Congressman Kanjorski how Rule 151A will impact your business as a small business owner. You can have an impact and we encourage you to contact his office.

We are providing you with the best ways to reach out to Congressman Kanjorski in order of effectiveness.

- Visit the local office in his District or his office in D.C. – there is no substitute for personal contact, even when the contact is with Staff
- Make a phone call to his offices (either local office or D.C. office)
- Fax a note to his office – avoid the potential that an email has of being screened by a spam-blocker
- Send an email – avoid the delay often experienced with “snail mail” which must be pre-screened since the post-9/11 Anthrax scare
- Send a letter – if you just can’t resist using a pen to write
